Services provided

Community nurses provide a range of care and support to patients 18 years or over with a Medway GP who have a health need and are housebound (the term 'housebound' means that a patient is physically unable due to illness or surgery to leave their home. A patient's 'housebound' status can vary over time).

They are based in local care teams and are well placed to access expert knowledge from other team members and local community networks. This includes, if required, undertaking assessments with social care colleagues. Services available include the following:

Chronic disease management to maintain stability, promote independence and reduce avoidable hospital admissions

Comprehensive individual assessment of needs to develop individual care plans **Continence care:** skilled assessment, provision of aids, catheter and bowel management

Health promotion: general and specialised advice and support including help to stop smoking

Leg ulcer clinics: treatment and advice for leg ulcer patients able to access a clinic setting

Medicines management: advice and support about medication, disconnection of chemotherapy, intravenous therapy and provision of equipment for enteral feeding regimes

Monitoring and screening:

chronic disease management, diagnostic procedures and phlebotomy (blood tests)

Palliative care: management and symptom control for patients living with life limiting conditions and end of life care.

Provision of equipment: advice and assessment to help maintain activities of daily living and meet nursing needs

Skin care: pressure areas and post operative wound care

Working hours and how to refer

Community nursing is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Referrals are welcomed from GPs, health and social care professionals.

The community nurses are based in local care teams so please phone or email your nearest team.

To contact a community nurse between the hours of 5pm and 9am (Mon - Fri), weekends and bank holidays, please call MCH OneCall
